42. TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 [AS AMENDED] LAND AT: SWINFEN HALL HOTEL, THE DRIVE APPEAL AGAINST ENFORCEMENT NOTICE RELATED TO UNAUTHORISED ERECTION OF MARQUEE

The Parish Clerk informed Members that she had received a letter dated 12 September 2023 from the Development Management Team, Lichfield District Council [letter circulated at the meeting]. The letter referred to an appeal against the enforcement notice issued by Lichfield District Council which related to the unauthorised erection of a marquee at the Swinfen Hall Hotel.

RESOLVED That the Parish Council would email the Planning Inspectorate [TeamE1@planninginspectorate.gov.uk] by no later than 23 October 2023 with the following objection:

- a. the site is located wholly within the Green Belt. The marquee comprises inappropriate development within the Green Belt.
- b. Swinfen Hall is Grade II* listed and the marquee is an incongruous form of development that would cause harm to the listed building by virtue of its design, scale and massing.
- c. Swinfen and Packington Parish Council is particularly concerned at the noise and traffic implications to the neighbouring residential properties.
- d. the marquee, by virtue of the noise generated and associated disturbance, would result in an unacceptable impact on the amenity of neighbouring residents.
