28. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Councillors Armstrong, Barnes, Perks and Mrs Pope.

29. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

None declared.

30. MINUTES

RESOLVED That the Minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on 10 July 2024 [Minute Nos. 17-27] as circulated, be approved as a correct record.

31. CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

Councillor Dyott referred to email correspondence which he had had with Councillor Barnes regarding flooding on the A51 and confirmed that he will take suitable photographs (this will go into abeyance until we have a downpour) so that the defect can be reported to Staffordshire County Council as Highway Authority. We are still awaiting a site visit with County Councillor Alan White regarding the junction of Lichfield Road, coming out of Whittington, with the A51 Lichfield - Tamworth Road.

Councillor Dyott referred to the letter received via an email dated 12 September 2024 from Lichfield District Council relating to an enforcement appeal which had been lodged against an Enforcement Notice that had been served by Lichfield District Council in respect of Swinfen Hall Hotel, The Drive and was considered unacceptable to the Council for the following reasons:

- a. The unauthorised engineering operation to create an earth bund.
- b. The unauthorised engineering operation to create an outdoor swimming pool.

- c. The unauthorised operational development to erect ornate metal pillars and gates over 2 metres in height.
- d. The unauthorised use of an existing flat roof (above the existing cocktail lounge) as a balcony.

It was **agreed** that the Parish Council sends a general comment to The Planning Inspectorate – That the Parish Council supports Lichfield District Council in maintaining the integrity of the Listed Building.

32. THE HIGH-SPEED RAIL PLANS

Councillor Loescher confirmed that he together with Councillor Barnes had met with representatives from HS2 and Balfour Beatty Vinci on Tuesday 09 July 2024 to chase up answers to and reiterate the points raised previously. It was **agreed** that Councillor Loescher would draft an email to BBV reminding them of their promises.

RESOLVED That the CIL unspent to date totalling \pounds 1,980.22 be noted.

34. IMPASSABLE FOOTPATH
